NOTE 1 – Summary of Significant Accounting Policies

These financial statements are special purpose financial statements prepared in order to satisfy the financial reporting requirements of the Associations Incorporation Act 1964 (Tas.). The committee has determined that the association is not a reporting entity.

These financial statements have been prepared on an accruals basis and are based on historical costs. They do not take into account changing money values or, except where stated specifically, current valuations of non-current assets.

The following significant accounting policies, which are consistent with the previous period unless stated otherwise, have been adopted in the preparation of these financial statements.

Significant Accounting Policies:

1. Property, Plant & Equipment

Plant & equipment are included at cost or, where indicated, at independent or owners valuation. All items of plant & equipment are depreciated over their useful lives commencing from the time the asset is held ready for use.

2. Income Tax

No provision for income tax has been raised as the entity is exempt from income tax under Div 50 of the Income Tax Assessment Act 1997.

Report on the Audit of the Financial Report

Qualification

Accordingly, our audit in relation to fundraising was limited to amounts recorded.

The association does not have comprehensive supporting documentation for every payment made. As a result our audit was limited to the extent that testing of payments to supporting documentation could not be performed for every payment selected.

Qualified Audit Opinion

We have audited the financial report of Southern Tasmanian Badminton Association Inc. (the registered entity), which comprises the statement of cash balances and accumulated funds as at 30 June 2021 and the statement of income and expenditure.
