Social Sessions

Announcement:

STBA Management has been working hard behind the scenes on our social sessions with the aim to ensure that these sessions remain social and enjoyable for all participants.

On that basis we have made some adjustments to the sessions, which have been active from the 1st of November.

These changes are:

- The Intermediate session is **ONLY** for players of Division 3 or equivalent standard and above.
- The Beginner session is **ONLY** for Division 4 players or equivalent standard and new players to the STBA.
- The Vets session is **ONLY** for players aged 35+ years and above.
- There will now be one price for all sessions, \$16, regardless of what time you arrive or for how long you would like to play for (to facilitate easier management of the session).



We have also updated our social session guidelines, to read them, <u>please click here</u>. These guidelines are active as of now and shape the way in which players should participate in Social Sessions.

These changes will be monitored over the coming weeks to ensure that they achieve what was intended. We would also like to reinforce that we are continuing our review of our social sessions to ensure that players of all levels have the capacity to attend social sessions. If there are reduced numbers attending the sessions as a result of our changes we will be looking at opening up more courts for public bookings. We are also reviewing the timings of the sessions to ensure that they are at times that are appropriate for all.
